Program Description

Laparoscopic techniques are becoming more and more interesting for gynecological surgeons, and laparoscopy is emerging as the gold-standard approach for many procedures according to the many hundreds of randomized studies. 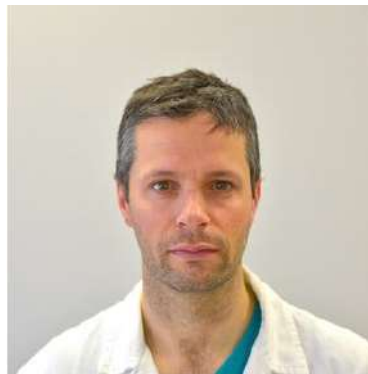
